B CALL TO ORDER

C INTRODUCTIONS

D OFFICERS REPORT

1. CHAIR -- DAVID NOLAN

David Nolan noted that he will be a speaker at the Tax Day Tea Party April 15, 2009. He will be speaking some time in the morning after 10:00 AM. It is anticipated that Tax Parties will take place in over 300 cities. This event was partially organized by Ron Paul's Campaign for Liberty.

2. TREASURER -- DAVID EUCHNER (Not present)

David Euchner was not able to attend, but he had e-mailed his report to the Board. The report shows that \$1,374 has been paid out for Registration Drive and \$2,627 has been received for a total balance of \$5,483.

E OLD BUSINESS

1. UPDATE ON VOTER REGISTRATION -- DAVID NOLAN

A total of 1800 to 2000 registrations are needed by October. Maricopa County and Pima County are on schedule for getting the required signatures for the state and their respective counties.

F NEW BUSINESS

1. MEDICAL CHOICE -- DAVID NOLAN

It appears that a discussion on this topic might come up in the Legislature with the possibility that it could be placed on the ballot and pass. The last initiative lost by only 1,500 votes.

2. LIBERTARIAN PARTY LITERATURE

Ben Kalafut noted that the Arizona LP Newsletter is almost finished and should be mailed soon. It will be mailed to all registered Libertarians, approximately between 17,000 to 18,000. He also noted that he has a box of LP literature, and it is available by contacting him.

3. PRESENTATION BY TERRY BRESSI

Terry gave the history of his experience with the Border Patrol and other police agencies. It started with his arrest when he refused to answer certain questions. He won in court and has filed a civil suit. Recently he was issued a citation for obstructing traffic. This was harassment by the police for previous activities. He is going to court tomorrow to fight the citation. He presented a preview of the main arguments he is planning to use.
